

CODE OF ETHICS FOR PLAYERS, PARENTS/SPECTATORS

PLAYER:

- Know and abide by the rules.
- Respect your coach, the referees, teammates, and opposing players.
- Remember that good sportsmanship and working hard are more important than winning.

The following are examples of when a red card may be issued and a player ejected from the game, but not limited to that game:

- Abusive language to an official, player, coach, or spectator, or
- Aggressive physical contact with a referee or other players, or
- Using or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol during a game, or
- Two cautions (yellow cards)

Pending the application of a red card, the Ashwaubenon Soccer Board will review the incident and has the authority to implement further suspensions or expulsions.

Penalties assessed that are longer than the remaining season will be carried over to the next season.

PARENTS / SPECTATORS:

- Exhibit exemplary behavior. Be a role model for all players and other parents.
- Always treat referees and your child's coach with respect.
- Stress to your child that good sportsmanship and playing hard are more important than winning.
- Encourage your child. Please do not yell at your child on the soccer field or engaging in behavior that will embarrass your child.
- Please do not coach from the sidelines. Leave that to the coach.
- Please do not referee from the sidelines. Leave that to the referee.

The following behaviors of parents and spectators are possible causes for a red card to be issued to a coach and his or her ejection from the game, but not limited to that game and/or termination of the game:

- Abusive language to an official, player, coach, or spectator, or
- Threatening actions or words to an official, player, coach, or spectator, or
- Aggressive physical contact with a referee or other players, including bumping, kicking, striking, or
- Using or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol during a game, or
- Two cautions (yellow cards)

Pending the application of a red card, the Ashwaubenon Soccer Board will review the incident and has the authority to implement further suspensions or expulsions.

Penalties assessed that are longer than the remaining season will be carried over to the next season.
